

The INTERNATIONAL MUSEUM OF THE STUDENT is a unique project, non-profit and pioneer in the world, dedicated to promote and disseminate the history of student life.

The collection has material from the 16th to the 21st centuries, coming from seventy seven countries of the five continents. The funds, which exceed three thousand original pieces, are owned by Roberto Martinez del Rio and are part of the directory of "Hispana" digitization projects of the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports of Spain.

The Museum aims to serve as reference, consultation, dissemination, study and research of the history of education, with special reference to the history of universities, covering the period from the creation of the first studies to today. This museum space will allow visitors to enjoy the rich and extensive legacy that students have left over the centuries.

# The Foundation



The INTERNATIONAL MUSEUM OF THE STUDENT FOUNDATION was established in July 2022, with the aim of protecting, promoting and disseminating the historical heritage of the student world, through the creation of the International Museum of the Student, which will house and exhibit the international student life collection owned by Roberto Martínez del Río, as well as other collections that may be incorporated in the future.

Additionally, the purpose of the FOUNDATION is to promote and contribute to education and culture, by carrying out activities aimed at helping students without resources, especially vulnerable or at risk of social exclusion, so that they can carry out their studies regardless of their origin, seeking the generation of employment opportunities and promoting their social and labor insertion.


